

Itinerary suggestions from Jezera - Sibenik region - 7 days of sailing

SUN Jezera – Sali on Dugi Otok ca 25 NM

Sail towards Dugi Otok leaving Kornati Islands on the left. The port of **Sali** has numerous berthing options and is very popular among sailors for its unique vibe. Sali is the municipal and administrative centre of the island and the place with the largest population and a very well established tourism. In Sali guests have a medical and dental clinic, a post office, an ATM, a Harbour branch office at their service. In the reading-room in Sali one can read or borrow books in several languages, and the reading-room was the organizer of many interesting events such as Sali's presentation of traditional dishes and classical music concerts. From Sali you can make a half day excursion to the **Nature Park Telašćica** which is located in the southeastern part of the island. The Telašćica bay is one of the safest, most beautiful and largest natural ports in the Adriatic. Don't miss the opportunity to climb the **cliffs of the island Dugi otok** vertically falling down 90 m into the sea and the **salt lake "Mir"**.



Sali

MON Sali – Island Ravni Žakan, Kornati ca 25 NM

From Sali head SSE to the entrance to the Kornati Islands – Proversa Mala (beware of the shallow waters at the passage and among the islands) and enjoy sailing through the Kornati Islands National Park taking a stop for the swim in the crystal blue waters or a nice meal at one of the numerous restaurants. Spent the night on the Ravni Žakan Island (mooring with water and electricity, excellent restaurant). Don't forget to take a walk around and to the top of the island for the breathtaking view (especially at sundown or sunset). TIPP: buy the national park ticket in the base marina for half the price than in the park

TUE Island Ravni Žakan, Kornati – Island of Zlarin with swimstop at Borovnjaci Islands ca 15 NM

Sail E to the island of Kakan (again taking care of the undepths along the way) and his eastern shore with two picturesque islands of Borovnjaci who form a beautiful and large anchorage where you can stop for a nice swim and meal. Refreshed head toward the island and port of Zlarin. There is plenty of mooring place with water and electricity. The place itself is car free with plenty of mediterranean village charm – picturesque stone houses, large waterfront with all of the life going on at it, beautiful beaches and lots of vegetation along the "lungo mare". The island is famous for its corals and its 6 centuries long coral tradition. Coral jewelry is also a great idea for an original souvenir.



Zlarin

WED Island of Zlarin – Skradin ca 18 NM

Leave Zlarin behind and sail up the sv. Ante channel towards the town of Šibenik, passing by the impressive Saint Nicholas fortress built in the 16th century by the famous Italian army engineer Michele Sanmicheli. Admire the magnificent view of Šibenik town from the sea. Sail up the Krka river to the town of Skradin where you can find a berth in the ACI marina. Skradin is a romantic Mediterranean town with narrow paved streets, passages, vaults and stairs. The entire town core represents a protected cultural monument. It contains houses dating from the 18th and 19th century which are stuccoed in the manner typical for Venice and areas under her influence. On the streets of Skradin you will find the pleasant atmosphere of a small Dalmatian town, especially during the Skradin festival of klapa singing (a capella singing typical for the Croatian Adriatic) or during the celebration of the Nativity of the Virgin Mary. Climb up the hill to a belvedere and early medieval fortress of ban Pavao Šubić of Bribir from the 13th or 14th century and visit the baroque Catholic Church of the Parturition of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Skradin is also the starting point for the excursion (plan ca 3 hours) to the National Park Krka - a natural karst phenomenon with its travertine waterfalls, opulent green vegetation and clear blue river – a true must see of the region. The national park can be reached via excursion boat (price in ticket included - 110 kuna per person, every full hour 08 - 18 h) or via bike on a nice near the river one hour ride. There are some bike rentals at the seafront of the village.



Skradin

THU Skradin – Prvić Luka on Prvić Island ca 18 NM

This little island can still be considered a hidden gem. Not very touristic and crowded it kept the charm of a small Adriatic island town. There are two places on the island Prvić Luka and Šepurine, with Prvić Luka offering safer berthing options. They are car free and a beautiful 10 min walk away through scented Mediterranean vegetation. The whole island is under protection of the Croatian Ministry of Culture since the island is considered a cultural heritage. Famous Croatian bishop and inventor (his biggest invention is the parachute) Faust Vrančić is buried in a church in Prvić Luka. In Šepurine his family owned a big baroque-style summer residence. The very interesting modern Faust Vrančić memorial centre can be visited in the port of Prvić Luka. Prvić island has been the summer vacation and plague escape spot for noble families from Šibenik since the 15th century. End of August/beginning of September a traditional Latin sail sailing boat regatta "Burtiž" takes place in Prvić Luka.

FRI Prvić Luka – Jezera ca 10 NM

After you've enjoyed a very Croatian long lasting coffee time in the morning in one of the many cafes in Prvić, use your last day of vacation for some relaxed sailing through the Šibenik archipelago. Take a stop for a swimming and exploring one of the numerous bays of Tijat, Kakan, Kaprije or Zmajan, have a fresh fish lunch in a seaside konoba before returning to the base marina in the evening hours. In case of good weather and no damage on your boat feel free to spend the last night on anchor in some bay near Jezera, but please make sure you are back in marina Jezera by 08 h on Saturday morning.

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
